

CONTROLLING REMOTE HOSTS

Remote Hosts are the interface between user written application programs and the Bank's Gateway system. They are never-ending tasks that execute in subsystem **BDS**. They are started and stopped using the **STRCCRMTH** and **ENDCCRMTH** commands, which can be placed in user written CL programs. The Administrator prior to starting them must define remote Hosts.

Starting Remote Hosts

The **STRCCRMTH** command has the following parameters:

Remote Host to start (RMTHOST) Parameter

Specifies the Remote Host to start.

Ending Remote Hosts

The **ENDCCRMTH** command has the following parameters:

Remote Host to end (RMTHOST) Parameter

Specifies the Remote Host to end.

Wait until ended to continue (WAITEND) Parameter

Specifies if the command is to wait for the Remote Host job to end before continuing.

***NO:** Control is returned to the calling program immediately.

***YES:** Control is returned to the calling program only after the Remote Host has ended. This option may be useful if tasks that need the Remote Host to be down, such as a backup of library **BDSDATA**, are performed in a CL program after the **ENDSORMTH** command.
